

UNT BSM: Touching Tomorrow, Today

The current Baptist Student Center at UNT opened in 1960 with a student enrollment of 6,500 students. In 2011 there are over 39,000 students enrolled.

The new building has a projected cost of \$2.275 million. Fundraising began in 2009 which has resulted in gifts over \$500,000. More is needed before construction can begin.
